Camp Resolute—We Do More

Eligibility and Conduct

- A verification will be performed on all applicant's age (age 13 for Horsemanship, Flyfishing, and Shooting Sports, age 15 for BSA Lifeguard), Hard Copy application and Code of Conduct signed by Scout, Parent or Guardian, and Scoutmaster required to attend. Specialty Camp is best for those scouts, regardless of age, who are mature enough to work on their badges independently.
- Applicants are required to attend a pre-camp meeting to review expectations and pre-camp requirements
- Applicants are required to reside at camp for the entire week – this will not be a day camp program.
- All accepted Specialty Campers are required to wear a complete scout uniform. Uniform shirt, shorts or slacks, belt, and socks. Class B Scout T-shirt, along with scout shorts/slacks, belt, and socks required for day use. Two Specialty T-Shirts will be issued to each candidate for day wear.
- All Specialty Campers are responsible for completing Merit Badge Pre-requisites prior to camp—failure to do so will result in partials.
- All Specialty Campers are expected to behave in an appropriate and non-disruptive manner

Mandatory Pre-Camp Meeting and Eagle Seminar

There will be a Mandatory Pre-Camp meeting on Wednesday August 3, 2011 for the 1st Troop meeting at Resolute 7PM. The Advancement Committee's Specialty Seminar will be run this evening for parents and scouts. This will be open to anyone, even if your son isn't attending Trail to Eagle camp. Starting time is 7:30PM. (confirming time with the advancement committee)
